## Welcome to Braceborough Hall

Braceborough Hall is an early Victorian residence set in an acre of lawns and trees. The Hall has, in recent years, been extensively modernised to the highest standard whilst retaining it's original character.

At Braceborough Hall Retirement Home we pride ourselves on our comfortable, relaxed atmosphere and our sensitive approach to the needs of our residents.

#### Accommodation

The hall provides accommodation for up to 24 elderly residents. The spacious ground floor includes: two lounges; one has a colour television and the other is a 'quiet' lounge and lounge/diner, one main dining room and a conservatory with views of the beautifully kept gardens.



We have ground floor and first floor bedrooms, accessible by chair lift, all of which are tastefully and cheerfully furnished and equipped with remote control televisions, a call-bell system and telephone points.

There are 10 single rooms with ensuite (3 of which are used for respite and rehabilitation), 10 single rooms without en-suite and 2 shared rooms with ensuite. The bathrooms are a combination of showers and baths and we have specialist equipment such as hoists for the disabled.



We also have visitors facilities at Braceborough Hall. This enables us to provide accommodation and meals if required for visitors who have a long way to travel and would rather stay overnight.



#### Medical Care

Our resident's medical needs are completely covered by local G.P.'s and health centres. Most residents can remain under the care of their own G.P., but for those who come to stay with us from further afield, we will register them with the local G.P. practice. The G.P.'s regularly



visit their patients, ensuring excellent on-site medical care. Arrangements are also made for home-visits by the dentist, chiropodist and optician.

#### Braceborough Hall Staff

You can expect excellent standards of professional care from our highly trained and skilled care staff, who are very sensitive to the needs of the individual residents. Qualification and grading details of staff are available on request. The home is managed and run by the owner, who is a qualified Registered General Nurse (R.G.N.)

#### Food and Special Diets

Our resident cooks provide tasty and nutritious meals and will take into account personal wishes and special requirements with regard to health, culture or vegetarianism. Meals can also be provided for visitors by prior arrangement.



#### Religious and Social Needs

All pastoral care needs can be accommodated. There is a communion service held within the home on the last Thursday of every month, and St. Margarets C of E Church is a two minute walk from Braceborough Hall. For other denominations, pastoral visits can be arranged.

#### Leisure Activities

There is a full programme of activities and entertainment (both in-house and outings), arranged seasonally throughout the year. Visitors are also welcome at all times.

#### Fees


